We shared seats on the school bus going to Seth Low I.S. 96. The Murchison Family was that family (at least in my family) where my mother would send me to their 2nd floor apartment with a note. And I was embarrassed to knock on the door because the note was begging for food. Gail normally would answer the door, I'd wait in the hallway with another sibling and then she would open the door with flour, rice, or even a couple of dollars. My mother did this at their door plenty of days and I always hated to knock but the Murchison Family fed my family plenty of days. And that has to be a testament to the Patriarch and Matriarch of their family, Mr. David Lee and his wife. I knew the family to be religious Pentecostals. And I knew their children to be very obedient to their parents. Before boarding the bus every morning me and Michelle would go to "Cheap Joes". He sold penny candies on Mermaid Ave between W24th and W25th. We went all the time until one day, Cheap Joe cheated Michelle out of some candy or change. I was her witness that Cheap Joe made a mistake but he angrily refused to correct the mistake he owed Michelle. Michelle's parents told her never to shop in Cheap Joe's store again. But he was the only store at the time where you can get 50 items of different candies and chocolates for 50 cents and my greedy self wanted more candy and tried to persuade Michelle to come back to the store and buy candy before our school bus come, that her parents would not know because we "both" would not say nothing about it. Michelle obeyed her parents and never entered that store again. I know of Mr. David Lee and his wife as being very generous human beings. To have the large family that they had and was still willing to help feed the hungry is a very generous thing, a testament to their soul and spirit and the discipline by way they taught their children is something I will never forget. I thank the Murchison Family for being there for my Mother and her hungry children. I try to feed the hungry today because when I was hungry families like the Murchisons fed me. Rest in Peace Mr. Murchison and my belated condolences to the family. I wish I would have known, I would have paid my respects and wanted to share this story to the mourners and to give an old friend I haven't seen in over 40 years a nice big hug.
